




Ham it up! Pronounce words in OldSpel the way they're spelled.
Knee is k-nee (kəni), gnaw is g-naw (gəna), etc.

goodbye, knee (Informal *həlo*; formal *helo*)

out, here (*hear* = *hiər*)
Mega = million; *giga* (not *jigə*) = billion.
